


# HR 6201 – Families First Coronavirus Response Act

### Paid Emergency Leave

- •Employers with 500 or fewer employees are required to provide 14 days of paid sick leave at regular rate
- •Employers are also required to provide "job protected" medical leave for up to 12 weeks with twothirds pay
- •Paid sick leave will be reimbursed by the Secretary of the Treasury through dollar for dollar tax credits/refunds

## Federal Emergency Paid Leave Benefits

- •Two-thirds monthly salary
- After worker has used the 14 days Paid Emergency Leave
- Provides \$1 billion for emergency grants to states to assist with processing and paying unemployment insurance
- Additional Food Aid
